



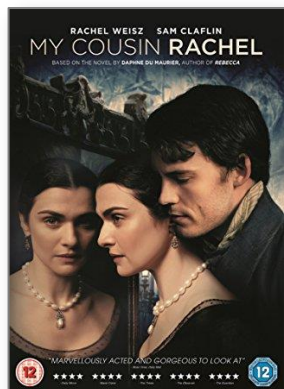
# COMING SOON

A heart-warming & hilarious 'coming of age' story. Set in rural France, where 16-year-old Paula is an indispensable interpreter for her deaf parents and brother, especially in the running of the family farm. Then she discovers an amazing gift for singing, and has to struggle between leaving the family for Paris to pursue her dream, or stay at home to care for her family who depend so much on her. Mystery-romance set in the 1830s and based on Daphne du Maurier's 1951 novel: a young man meets the wife of his older cousin, suspecting her of being responsible for his death. Filmed in ravishingly beautiful & historic settings at Flete Estate in Devon and West Horsley Place in Surrey.
